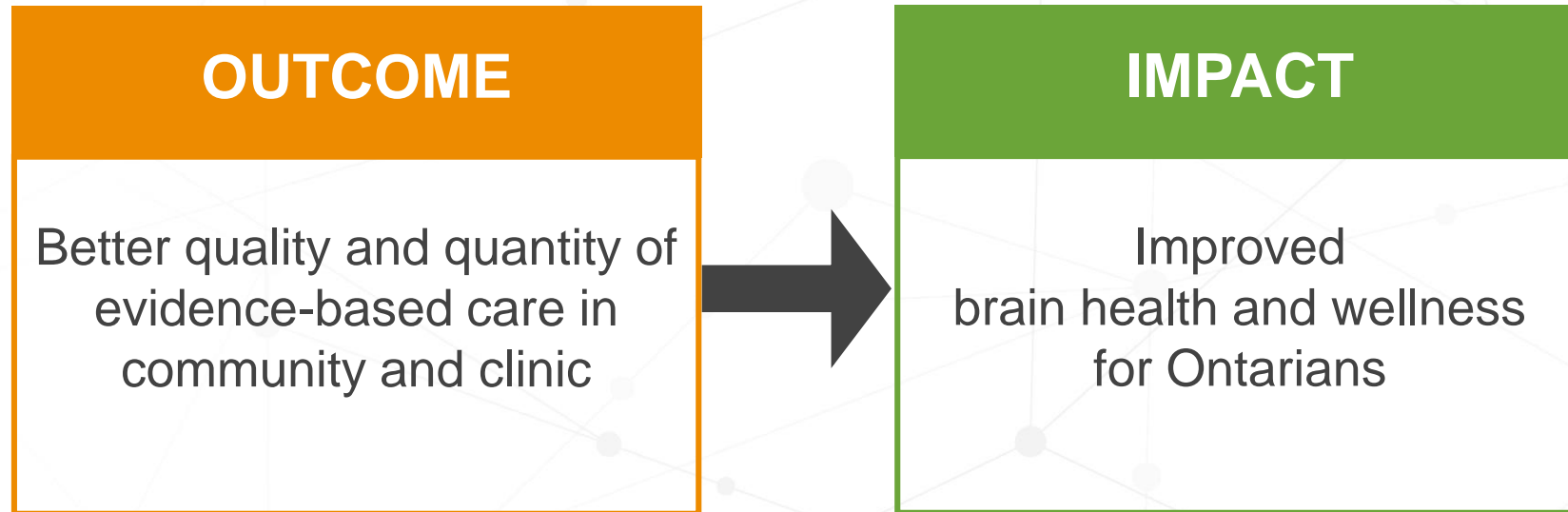

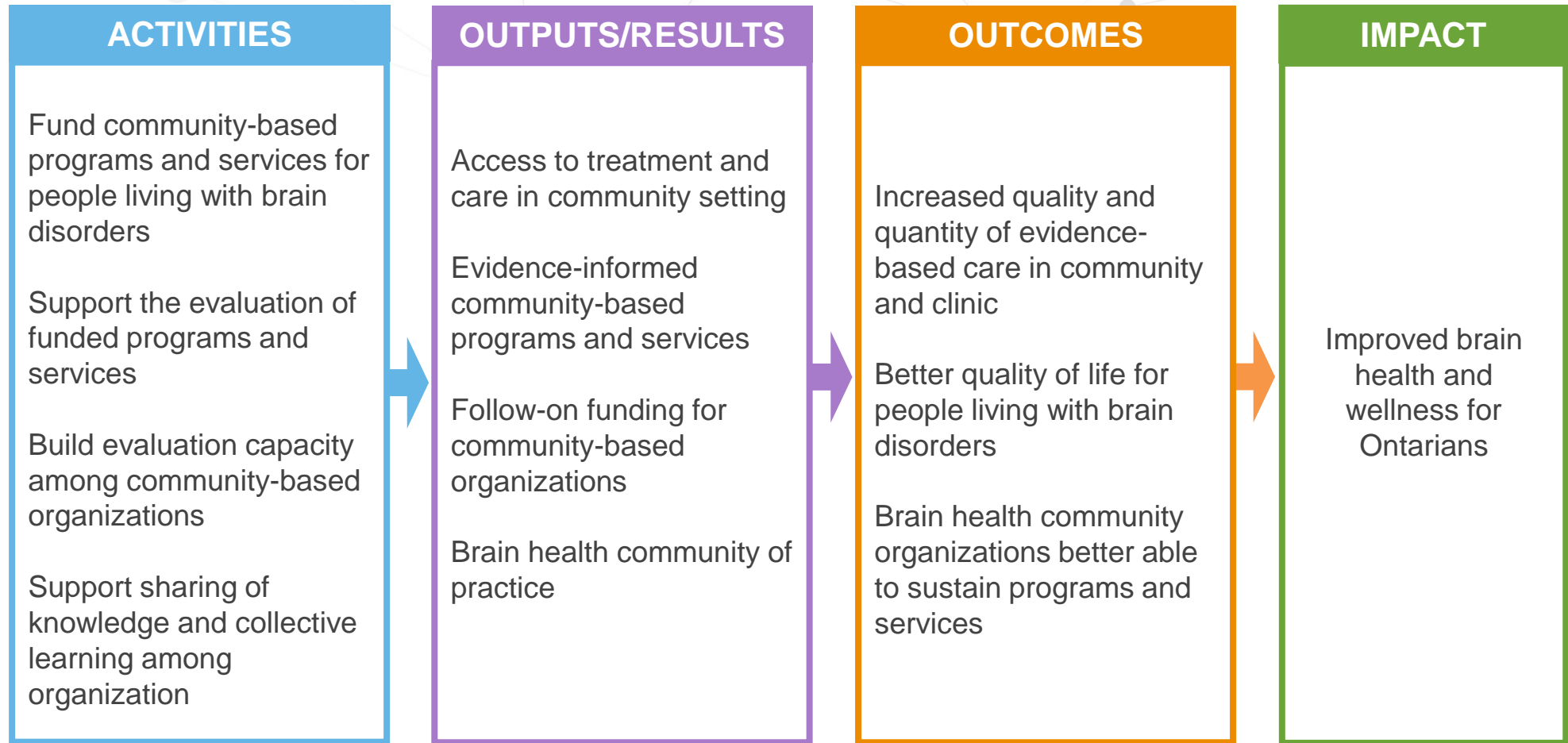


The GEEK Program

- Supporting scale, spread, sustainability, and evaluation of community-led programs and services.
- GEEK provides funding, evaluation support, and other supports.
- \$1M+ over 5 years.
- Seeking to fund programs that represent a range of brain disorders and from a range of regions in Ontario.



GEEK Logic Model





Eligibility Criteria

1. The applicant is a community-led organization.
2. The program or service is brain and/or mental-health related.
3. Funding supports activities taking place in Ontario.
4. The program or service is currently or has previously been offered.
5. The program is community-led and takes place outside of a hospital or primary care setting.
6. The applicant is an incorporated organization with prior or existing funding.

- Deadline: Friday, September 27, 2019
- Reviewed by OBI Review Committee
- Decision by: Friday, October 18, 2019

Full Application and Interview

- Invitation to successful LOIs
- Matched with an evaluator
- Deadline: December 20, 2019
- Reviewed by External Advisory Committee
- Interview: January 2020
- Decision by: Monday, January 27, 2020
