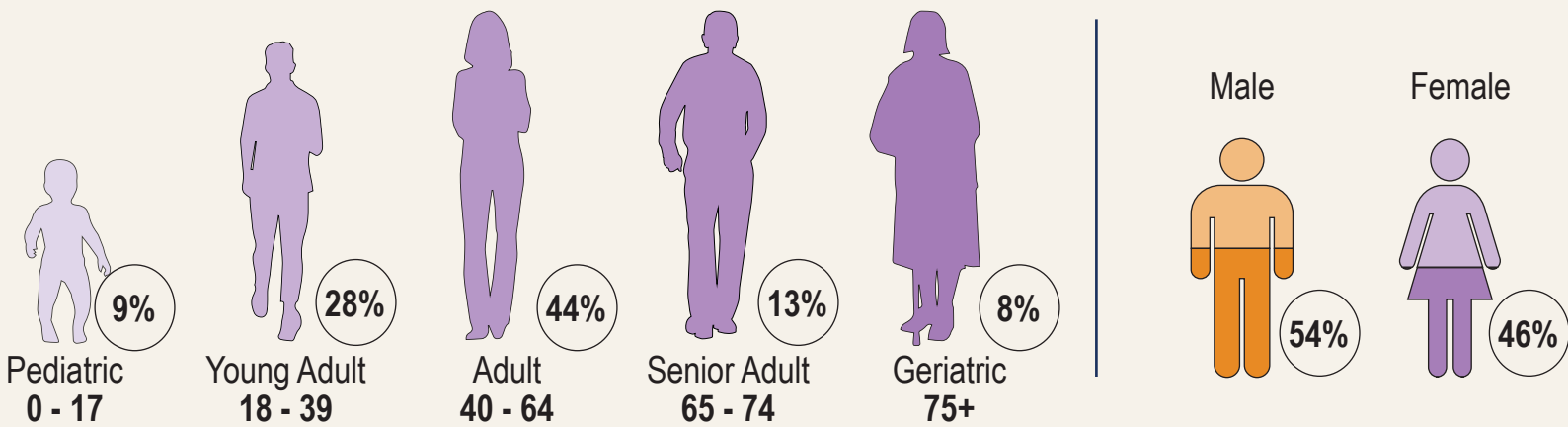

Compared to the average Ontarian, the annual **DIRECT COST** to the healthcare system is:
